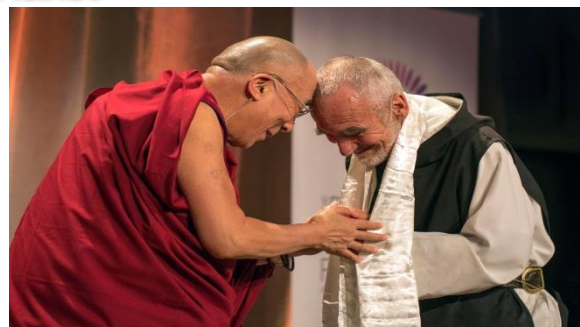

### Zen Buddhism and Christianity in Dialogue

**Aug. 7th & 21st, at 6:30PM.**

ZEN BUDDHISM AND CHRISTIANITY: Please join us for a two-part presentation about the insights gained through the inter-faith dialogue between Christian theologians and Buddhist teachers.

On the first night (August 7th), we'll cover an overview of the basic concepts of Buddhism and explain how Christians such as Merton, Steindl-Rast and Knitter have found similarities to Christian contemplative (apophatic) traditions.

On the second night (August 21st), we'll begin with a question and answer period, followed by an experience of Buddhist meditation, zazen, and a walking meditation, kinhin.
