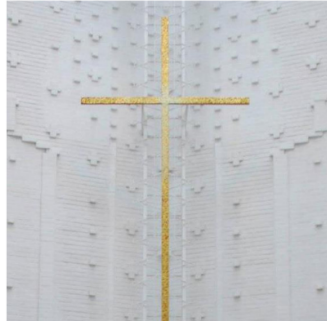
Texting is an easy way for people to access the My Well Giving platform, without the need to remember a specific URL.
